Congratulations to both of you on the birth of your child. All of us at St. Mary Magdalen are so happy for you.

In order for you to have your child baptized at St. Mary Magdalen it is necessary for the parents to participate in a "*Baptismal Preparation Class*". The classes are given usually on the first Tuesday of each month. If you have taken a class either at St. Mary Magdalen or any other Catholic church for this purpose, you will not be required to repeat the class.

The baptism can be celebrated after any weekend Mass; Saturday 4:30 pm Mass, Sunday 7:30 am, 9:30 am or 11:30 am Mass. Please select the time of baptism on the form for when you wish the Sacrament to be held. Please note, we will save the front pews on the left side of the main aisle for your family and friends.

Please download the form to your computer, save it, fill it in, save it again and then send the completed form to Info@StMMChurch.com. Once we receive the baptismal registration form, our Baptism Coordinator, Deacon Bill Preiss, will contact you to schedule the baptism class and confirm the day and time of your child's baptism.
